## \*Updates to the DPS6 Powershift Transmission Settlement Arbitration Process\*

- (1) Please take notice that class counsel, together with Ford's counsel, have agreed to change appellate arbitration providers. This change will result in a lower cost to any claimant who wishes to pursue an appeal of their arbitration result. The details are contained in the Revised Rules of Appellate Arbitration (click <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a> to view). The thirty-day deadline for pursuing an appeal will remain in place. However, for any claimant whose arbitration was decided prior to this notice and who has not previously pursued an appeal of the arbitration result, your opportunity to appeal will be retroactively reinstated so that you may take advantage of the lower cost of appeal if you so choose. This retroactive extension will expire thirty days from the date of this notice. Please contact the arbitration administrator, CAP Motors, with any questions.
- **(2)** If you currently have an eligible claim with CAP-Motors as part of the DPS6 Powershift Transmission Settlement that is currently in abeyance, or an eligible claim that has not been arbitrated due to lack of participation in the scheduling process, you have **ten days** from the date of this message to respond; indicating your readiness to actively participate in scheduling your claim for arbitration. Your response must include the type of hearing desired (documents-only, phone/video, or in-person) and dates of availability for phone/video/in-person hearings.

NOTICE: IF YOU DO NOT TAKE FURTHER ACTION, YOUR CLAIM WILL BE PUT IN ABEYANCE BEGINNING ON July 4, 2023 (20 days from the date of this message). IF YOU CONTINUE TO FAIL TO RESPOND AFTER THE ABEYANCE PERIOD EXPIRES, YOUR CLAIM MAY BE DELAYED UNTIL OTHER TIMELY FILED CLAIMS ARE ARBITRATED, AND A HEARING WILL BE SCHEDULED ON YOUR CLAIM THAT WILL PROCEED WITH OR WITHOUT YOUR FURTHER PARTICIPATION.

**(3)** If you previously submitted an incomplete claim to CAP-Motors as part of the DPS6 Powershift Transmission Settlement but have not provided the required information for an eligibility determination to be made, you have **thirty days** from the date of this message to submit the requested information or your claim will be closed.
